

# TACTICAL EMERGENCY CASUALTY CARE for Law Enforcement and First Responders TECC - LEO

# **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

The Tactical Emergency Casualty Care course for Law Enforcement and First Responders (TECC-LEO) meets the guidelines established by the Committee on Tactical Emergency Casualty Care (Co-TECC). An 8-hour classroom course specifically designed for law enforcement officers and other first responders and covers materials found in the 16-hour TECC provider course at a level appropriate for first responders. It includes interactive lectures, skill stations, and patient simulations. Upon successful completion of the course, students receive a certificate of completion, a wallet card recognizing them as a TECC-LEO provider for 4 years, and 8 hours of CAPCE credit for qualified participants. Additionally, the course is also approved for 8 hours of Georgia POST credit.

# **REGISTRATION:**

Applicants beyond that will be placed on a waiting list.

### COST:

Substitutions are allowed.

Lunch will be provided, and all attendees will receive a Bleeding Control Kit or IFAK. Travel expenses and all other meals will be the responsibility of the course participant.

This course normally would cost \$250-\$500 per person. Thanks to Regional Support funding provided by the Georgia Trauma Care Network Commission, the associate instructional costs and NAEMT course registration fee are grant funded.
