# ART CONTEST

OPEN TO PRE K-12 GRADE STUDENTS • ENTRIES STILL ACCEPTED

Central Georgia Region 5 Emergency Medical Services for Children (R5 EMSC), in partnership with the Region 5 Regional Trauma Advisory Committee (R5 RTAC), is excited to announce this year's EMS Region 5 Art Contest. This annual competition encourages students to use their creativity and talent to raise awareness of EMS professionals and how to stay safe. The art contest is open to four groups spanning pre-K through 12th grade.

## CONTEST AGE CATEGORIES

Students must be in the categories below as of the 2023-2024 school year. For example, a student who is in 4th grade would be a part of Category 2:

### Daycare & Pre-K Students:

- **Category 1:** Daycare Students and those Completing Pre K

### Elementary School Students:

- **Category 2:** Grade K-2
- **Category 3:** Grade 3-5

### Middle and High School Students:

- **Category 4:** Grade 6-8
- **Category 5:** Grade 9-12

## ACCEPTED ARTWORK

- **Hand-Drawn Art:** Crayon, colored pencil, marker, paint, etc
- **Digital Art:** Graphic design, digital drawing, etc
- **Craft:** Handmade items such as a collage, diorama, etc
- **Photo:** Captured with a phone or a digital camera

## CONTEST THEME CATEGORIES

Students' artwork should focus on a theme belonging to the two main categories below **1- EMS Awareness** and **2- Injury Prevention and Safety**. Students may create artwork using one of the suggested themes below or another related theme or topic of their choosing.

### EMS Awareness:

- **EMS: Caring for the Community**
- **EMS: Everyday Heroes**
- **EMS: One Mission, One Team**
- **EMS: Rising to the Challenge**
- **EMTs are My Friends**

### Injury Prevention and Safety:

- **ATV Safety:** Follow the Rules of the Off-Road
- **Bike Safety:** Wear A Helmet! Every Trip, Every Time
- **Bullying:** Be a Buddy, Not a Bully
- **Car Seat Safety:** Choose the Right Seat
- **Teen Driver Safety:** Experience is Key
- **Fire Safety:** Stop, Drop, and Roll
- **Fireworks Safety:** Your Safety Matters
- **Pedestrian Safety:** Be Safe, Be Seen
- **Roadway Safety:** Don't Drive Distracted
- **Seatbelt Safety:** Buckle Up - Every Trip, Every Time
- **Water Safety:** Life Jackets Save Lives
- **Wheeled Safety:** Love Your Brain - Wear A Helmet

**ALL Winners will receive:**

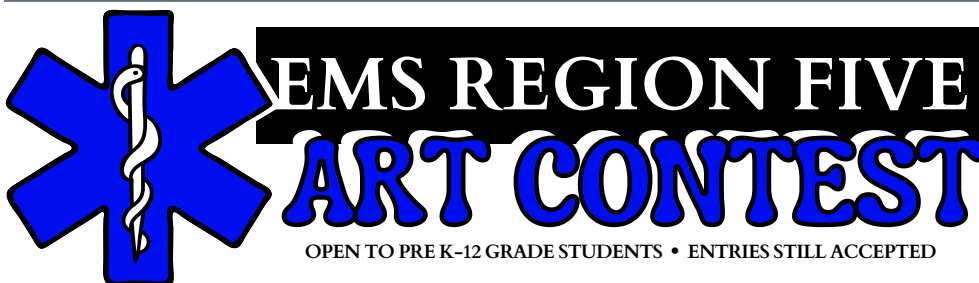
- Inclusion in a Winner Announcement Video

**Note: Partnering EMS agencies, hospitals, and organizations may elect to award additional recognition and prizes for local student submissions.**

## RULES FOR ALL ART CONTEST ENTRIES

All entries should focus on a theme belonging to two main categories **1- EMS Awareness** and **2- Injury Prevention and Safety**. Students may create artwork using one of the suggested themes (page 1) or another related theme or topic of their choosing. Additionally, all entries should adhere to the following rules.

1. **ENTRIES MUST BE HORIZONTAL (LANDSCAPE) IN LAYOUT OR ORIENTATION; VERTICAL LAYOUTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
2. Entries must be submitted by the May 14, 2024, deadline. Winners will be officially announced at the regional EMS for Children Cookout on May 21, 2024. All regional prizes will be awarded by May 31, 2024.
3. The entry must be received by Region 5 EMS for Children no later than 11:59 PM EST on May 14, 2024, by online upload or mail. No other method of entry will be accepted.
4. Students may submit multiple entries.
5. A parent or guardian must complete and sign the entry form.
6. The submissions must represent the student's own original work. It cannot be a copy or modification of another work, such as a picture that is copied and then colored.
7. Submissions must not include any copyrighted logos and brands, names of students, social media handles, or school names.
8. Software or online programs may be used to assemble/edit an entry. However, the entry must be primarily generated by the student's own creativity and concept.
9. All person(s) whose photo appears in a poster or photo entry must complete a video/photo release form.
10. Safety messages should be kept positive and show examples of safe behaviors. Seat belt usage for all people pictured in vehicles is mandatory. Helmet usage for all people on ATVs, bicycles, motorcycles, scooters, skates, skateboards, and UTVs is required. Additionally, physical safety is mandatory when capturing photos. Content must not be captured while operating a vehicle; riding a bicycle, scooter, or skateboard; or in any other dangerous situations.  
**Hint: Students should review the proper safety rules and gear needed for activities before getting started on their submission.**



# SUBMITTING ART CONTEST ENTRIES

All entries must be received by Region 5 EMS for Children **no later than 11:59 PM EST on May 14, 2024**, by online upload or mail. No other method of entry will be accepted.

## Online Upload Entry Instructions (preferred)

- Upload the Entry Form and student art submission(s) to <https://tinyurl.com/R5ArtContest>.
- Entries must be submitted as a high-resolution photo or scan. Accepted file types include JPG, PNG, or PDF and must not exceed 10MB.
- The completed and signed entry form must also be uploaded. Digital signatures are acceptable, or the parent/guardian may print, sign, scan, and email the form.
- Students and parents may upload multiple entries using a single-entry form.

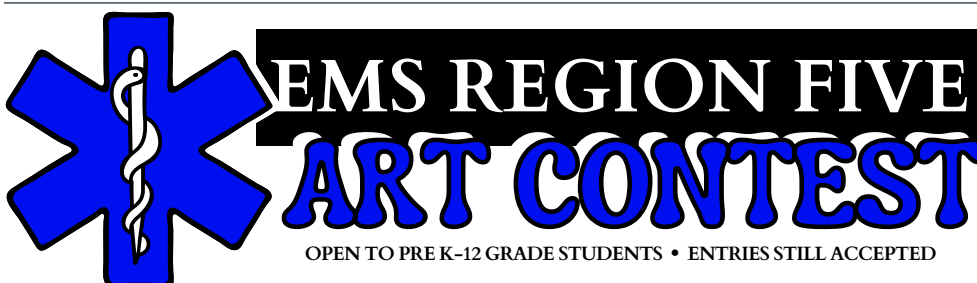
